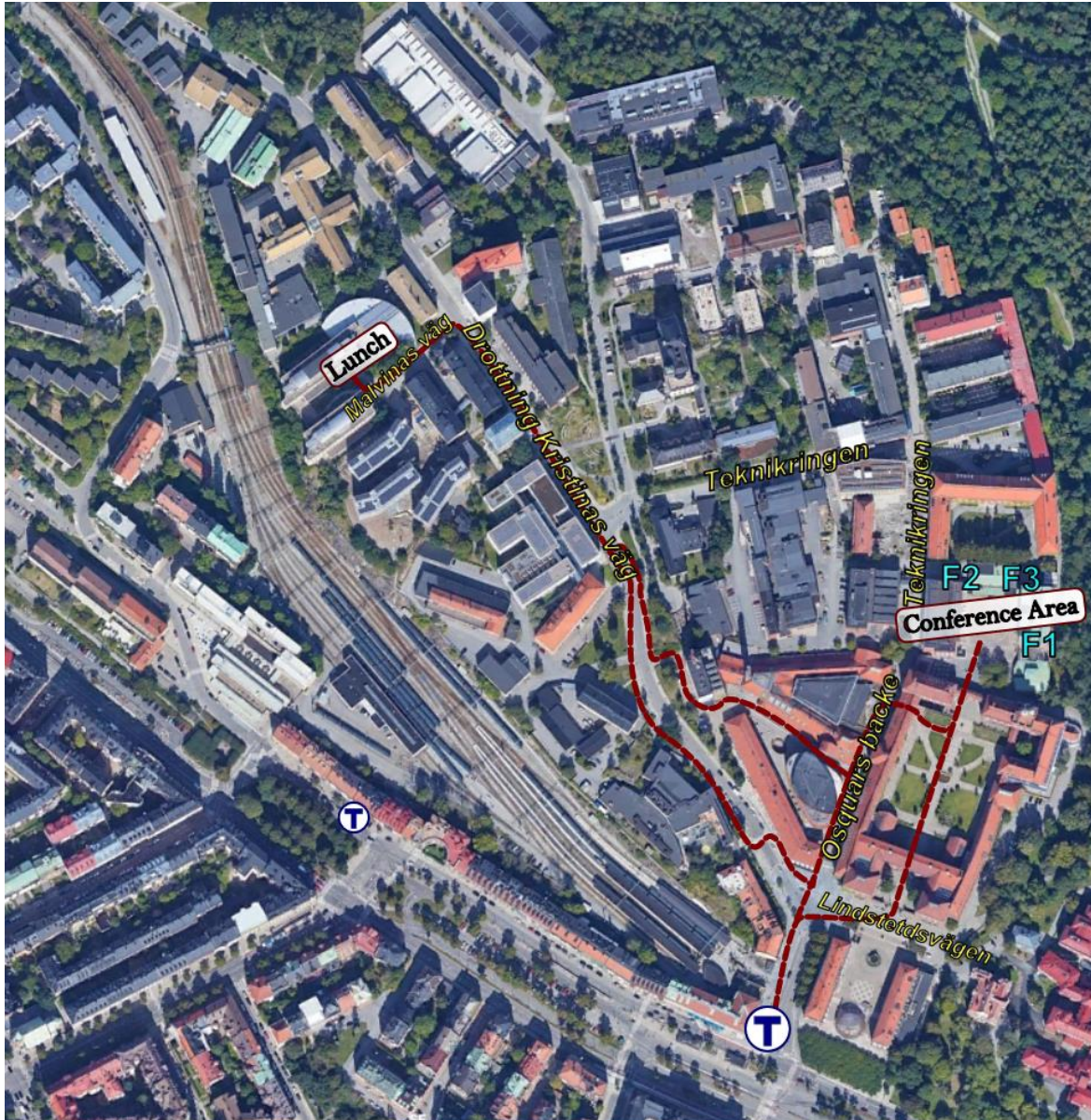

Language

English is the official language of the Conference.

Registration Desk

On **Monday June 17**, the registration desk will be open from **10.00 to 18.00**.

On **Tuesday June 18** the registration desk will be open from **08.30 to 18.00**.

On **Wednesday 19** the registration desk will be open from **09.00 to 17.00**.

Oral presentations

Plenary lectures, keynote lectures and oral presentations will be held in the **conference halls F1, F2, and F3** (see the scientific program for details).

Lecturers should bring their presentations on a USB key to upload them in the computer in the corresponding conference room **before the beginning of their session**.

Lecturers are kindly requested to introduce themselves to the chairperson before the start of the session and are advised to respect the pre-established time.

Poster presentations

The poster session will be held in the **tent in the conference area** outside Lindstedtsvägen 24-26. **Poster session 1** is on Tuesday **June 18** at **10.40-11.10** and **15.40-16.25**. **Poster session 2** is on **Wednesday June 19** at **11.10-11.40** and **14.00-14.45**.

Please put your poster on display on the panel with your name on **Tuesday June 18 (Poster Session 1) or Wednesday June 19 (Poster Session 2)** early in the morning and remove it after the afternoon coffee break (see scientific program for details).

Posters should be **110 x 90 cm** maximum. The organizers will provide all tools for attaching your poster to the corresponding panel.

During the conference, there will be **2 Best Poster Awards**. The Scientific Committee will select the Best Poster presented by a young researcher in each session.

Exhibition

The exhibition will be held in the **hallway outside of conference halls F2 and F3**.

Coffee breaks will be held in the **tent in the conference area** outside Lindstedtsvägen 24-26.

How to travel to/from KTH with bus/metro/commuter trains?

It is not possible to buy tickets directly on buses, trains, trams or boats. Three options with instructions are listed below:

Option 1: Buy an **electronic card** and load any number of single tickets or passes (24 h, 48 h, 72 h, weekly passes). Electronic cards are 20 SEK to buy (**debit or credit card only**) at SL Center (T-Centralen station) and other major stations like Slussen, Fridhemsplan, and Tekniska högskolan), as well as in convenience stores such as Pressbyrå inside the train stations (always check for the **SL logo!**).

Option 2: Buy a single ticket at a vending machine in the stations within Stockholm (debit or credit only, **no cash**).

Option 3: Buy tickets at the metro/commuter train booth (more expensive than Option 1, and please note that **only cash** is accepted in the subway booths)

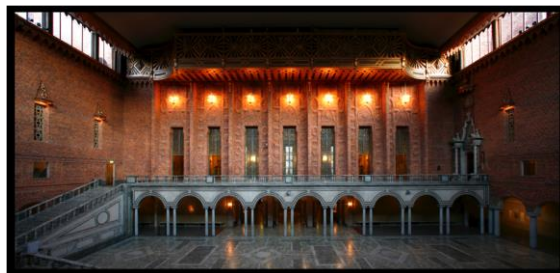

SOCIAL PROGRAM

Reception – Monday June 17 at 19.00 in the Stockholm City Hall

The City of Stockholm is hosting a reception in the **Stockholm City Hall** to honour the conference delegates. The Stockholm City Hall, situated in the heart of Stockholm city at **Hantverkargatan 1**, is probably the city's most famous landmark with its 106 meter high tower. It is the home of the Municipal Council, but also the host of hundreds of events and celebrations each year. The most famous event hosted in the City Hall is the world famous Noble Prize Banquet, which is held each year on December 10 in the magnificent Blue Hall.

The reception organized for BIOPOL is **free of charge**, but you will have to **bring the ticket** which is provided upon arrival to the conference, if you are registered for the reception.



Conference dinner – Tuesday 18 at 19.00 in the Vasa Museum

The BIOPOL conference dinner will take place at the **Vasa Museum at Galärvarvsvägen 14**. The Vasa Museum is one of Scandinavia's most visited museums. It is here that you will find the unique and well-preserved warship Vasa from 1628, embellished with hundreds of wooden sculptures.



The conference dinner is **included in the conference fee**, but you will have to **bring the ticket** which is provided upon arrival to the conference, if you are registered for the dinner. No specific dress code needed for the dinner.

Travel directions

To Stockholm City Hall (Stadshuset)

Address: **Hantverkargatan 1**, Stockholm

From Tekniska högskolan (KTH): 1) Take the metro, red line 14 (going towards Fruängen). Exit at T-Centralen and take the escalators up to Centralstationen, Vasagatan, and then walk to the City Hall. 2) From Östra station, take bus 4, 6, 67, or 72 to *Odenplan*. Change to bus 53 (going towards Henriksdalsberget). Exit the bus at stop *Stadshuset*. Travel time approximately 20 minutes.

To the Vasa Museum

Adress: **Galärvarvsvägen 14**, Stockholm

From T-Centralen (Central station): Take the tram line 7 (going towards Djurgården Waldemarsudde) and exit the tram at *Djurgårdsbron*. Walk ca 500 meters to the Vasa Museum, Galärvarvsvägen 14. Travel time approximately 15-20 minutes.

From Tekniska högskolan (KTH): Take bus 67 from Östra station (going towards Skansen). Exit the bus at *Nordiska Museet/Vasamuseet*. Walk ca 249 m to the Vasa Museum at Galärvarvsvägen 14. Travel time approximately 20-25 minutes.
